

**FLEETWOOD YOUTH SOCCER CLUB**  
**GENERAL MEETING MINUTES**  
**March 17, 2008**

Meeting called to order at 7:00pm by Dan Adamo.

**Secretaries Report:**

- Review of minutes from February 18, 2008.
- Motion to approve Secretaries Report by ??, seconded by Bud.
- Website update not available due to Secretary or Kevin Schukraft not in attendance.

**Treasures Report:**

- Savings account summary was not included due to their being no changes from last months report.
- No checks have gone out to Fleetwood Foundation as of yet for donation.
- \$400 has been given to Fleetwood girl's soccer team for warm-ups.
- Parent indicated they were disappointed in the reduction of team funds available; Lisa explained that the reduction in the team funds was due to an anticipated reduction in revenue from the Fleetwood Tournament this year.
- Steve indicated that parents made comments that the club has an abundance of funds available; Lisa explained that those funds were earmarked, in the past, for the possibility of purchasing land for soccer use. Lisa also explained that we may have to consider this next year when planning the budget.
- Motion to approve Treasurers Report by Bud, seconded by Bob.

**Registrar's Report:**

- In regards to spring girls registration, everything is done. All fees have been paid
- In regards to spring boys registration, had some additional changes, which were turned in today but will be finalized by Friday.
- Timeline for fall registration:
  - Forms going home through schools early next week (provided forms are distributed by teachers).
  - May 2, 2008 is deadline for registration. Those registrations received after this deadline will be put on waiting list.
  - U13 and U14 try-outs are 5/27/08.
  - U11 and U12 try-outs are 5/29/08.
  - U10 assessment is 6/2/08.
  - U9 assessment is 6/4/08.
  - All assessments and try-outs will be at Walnuttown field.
- May 4<sup>th</sup> FYSC Board meeting will involve a review of eligible coaches.
- New league registrar this year (possibly from Muhlenberg); therefore, there will be some learning curves in dealing with RBJSL.
- We are in need of U8 coordinators for the Fall 2008 season!

**Equipment:**

- Benches at Richmond are now complete. Within this past week FYSC received a call from a representative of Fleetwood that nets and benches located on the Fleetwood field should be removed or they would be destroyed. We obtained 12 nets (being stored at Walnuttown field) and 2 benches.
- If coaches need ice packs, zip ties for nets or any other equipment items, please contact Mark.
- Walnuttown flags are at Mark's house; this past weekend everything went smoothly with getting flags.
- U9 and U10 games forth going will be at Andrew Maier. John Diehl has the flags for that field.

**Reading Berks:**

- Attended by Danielle.
- Couple situations regarding relegations: U9's ended up T1 and that was their 3<sup>rd</sup> choice. Per Dan Adamo, it appeared during the relegation meeting, RBJSL indicated that everyone got their 1st choice, which wasn't the case. Also, Fleetwood had requested to not have teams pair up in same division (so as to avoid a Fleetwood vs. Fleetwood game) and there are a few situations where this is happening. Brad is following up with them on this issue and will have an update at the next meeting.
- Danielle indicated the RBJSL stressed that if there is a problem with a Referee, to bring that to their attention as soon as possible via e-mail or game report, rather than approaching the referee directly.
- RBJSL suggested a possible Q & A session with new coaches and a referee.
- To reschedule games, please go through John.

### **Field Commissioner Report:**

- Coaches - do not forget to report scores to John no later than Sunday night.
- John does not need to know when a game is postponed.
- U9 and U10 teams will move back to Andrew Maier.
- Lining schedule will be forth coming.
- Indoor practices have concluded.
- Fleetwood Bible Church – will be used for 1 full size or 2 smaller size fields for practices only.
- Per Lisa: Port-A-Potty is located at Richmond; however there is one all ready at Andrew Maier so we will not need to provide one.

### **Committee's:**

#### Fleetwood Tournament – Report by Danielle.

- We are unable to use Fleetwood fields; therefore, we are working on alternative locations.
- Received confirmation from Wilson Soccer Club that we could use their fields; however Spring Township has refused us use of the fields due to parking and other concerns.
- Contacted Berks County regarding the use of their fields. Received some resistance from the field representative regarding the use of the fields for this tournament. Danielle subsequently contacted a County Commissioner for assistance. We will have an answer by Thursday 3/20/08.
- If we get a negative response – the tournament committee will make a final decision as to where to go (whether it be a smaller tournament or no tournament).
- Suggestion if we do not have a tournament that we would notify teams that have all ready registered immediately and offer a \$25 deduction in next years registration.
- Next meeting date will be determined after speaking to County Commissioner.
- A decision needs to be made, as soon as possible, due to other tournament deadlines.
- A question was asked whether money would be refunded to those that have all ready registered? Danielle advised that the fees have not been deposited at this time and would be fully refunded.

- Deadline for 9v9 is beginning of April.
