

**FLEETWOOD YOUTH SOCCER CLUB**  
**GENERAL MEETING MINUTES**  
**February 18, 2008**

Meeting called to order at 7:03pm by Brad Cook.

**Secretaries Report:**

- Review of minutes from January 21, 2008.
- Dawn will work with Kevin to add Calendar of Events, as well as look into having individual coaches pages on FYSC website.
- Kevin Schukraft recommended removing the song "Eye of the Tiger" from website. Motion approved.
- Suggestion made to add important dates to Calendar of Events for parents – will be done.
- Motion to approve Secretaries Report by Steve, seconded by Bud.

**Treasurers Report:**

- As reported prior, team tournament money for spring is \$600.
- Coaches do not have pay Fleetwood tournament money; just notify FYSC Treasurer that you have submitted your registration & roster and funds will be deducted electronically.
- Motion to approve Treasurers Report by Bob, seconded by Bud.

**Registrar's Report:**

- If there are any outstanding Child Line or Child Abuse clearances by 1<sup>st</sup> game of spring season, those coaches will not be permitted on the sidelines.
- For the fall season, registration/information forms will be sent to the school district before Easter.
- Possible on-site registration will be in April/May time frame – please offer suggestions for improvements.
- Fall coach selection will be at the May FYSC Board Meeting.
- Tryouts will be late May.
- Question as to those that can't get PS1s? Depending upon situation will decide if an exception can be made.
- Question as to if coaches will know their teams prior to UK Elite camp? It is possible to take "probable" teams to camp; UK Elite will work with coaches.
- Changes to the roster are permitted up until 2<sup>nd</sup> week in season – teams must go to RBJSL by June, not necessarily roster.
- FYSC will need to work with High School boys to establish coaches for 9v9 for this summer.

- New club patch design was passed around. Order will be placed by the end of February. Design will be slightly different for Fleetwood Tournament. Use up current stock of patches until new ones come in.
- Shed clean out was a success. Thanks to those that assisted.
